



SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA 2011-2012

Honor Roll, Marie Gaby, and Oakley J. Gordon Memorial Scholarships

To be considered for a scholarship, students must:

1. Be a declared major in one of the undergraduate, degree-granting departments of the College of Social and Behavioral Science (Anthropology, Behavioral Science and Health, Economics, Environmental Studies, Family and Consumer Studies, Gender Studies, Geography, Political Science, Psychology, Social Science Composite Teaching, or Sociology);
2. Have a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA (except for the Gordon Scholarship which does not have a minimum GPA requirement);
3. Have been a full-time student (minimum of 12 hours per semester during the last year attended) for a full-time scholarship; or have been a part-time student (minimum of 6 hours per semester during the last year attended) for a part-time scholarship. (Part-time students are only eligible for the Honor Roll or Gordon scholarships). NOTE: You must maintain full-time (or part-time) enrollment for fall and spring semesters of the next academic year in order to be eligible for the scholarships.
4. Have completed 30 semester hours by Fall 2011 (including anticipated Summer 2011 enrollment);
5. Have a demonstrated financial need;
6. Must be a U.S. citizen or a citizen of another country who is lawfully present in the U.S.
