

Service Statement

Over the past several years, I have been actively involved in a variety of service roles at the department, local, and national level. At the department level, I have served on the undergraduate committee (2010-2016), clinical training committee (2009-Present), the personnel committee (2015-16, 2018-19), and the research participation committee (2018-2019). Within the clinical area, I coordinated our clinical Ph.D. clerkships/traineeships from 2010-2012, was the Associate Director of Clinical Training (DCT) from 2016-2017, and began 3-year term as DCT and clinical area head in 2019. Within the clinical area, I have served on 11 thesis committees (4 as chair), 8 dissertation committees (3 as chair), and 14 preliminary exam committees (4 as chair). Outside the department, I served as the co-director of the Tourette-Association of America Designated Center of Excellence (Department of Neurology) from 2014-2018 and have routinely guest lectured for college and university programs (e.g., the Solutions Scholars program, CSBS-SLCC symposium, Psychiatry/Neurology Department Grand Rounds, the U of U School of Medicine's Triple Board Residency program, etc.).

At the local and national level, I have conducted numerous workshops and community education events related to Tourette and tic disorders locally (including coordinating and speaking at our annual education event and speaker series) and throughout the country (see CV), including 36 workshops for the Tourette Association of America and Centers for Disease Control (10 in the past 5 years). For the past 5 years I have also served on the Medical Advisory Board, Diversity Committee, and Conference Review Committee for the Tourette Association of America and am one of the lead faculty instructors for their Behavior Therapy Training Institute, through which I have trained over 150 therapists in evidence-based practice for tic disorders. I have served as an ad-hoc reviewer for over 40 different peer-reviewed journals, for the past 5 years have been an editorial review board member for the journals *Behavior Therapy* and *Current Psychology*, and am an associate editor for the journal *Education and Treatment of Children*. In the past 5 years I have served as a guest reviewer on grant review panels for the NIH/NIMH, the Action Medical Research for Children Foundation (UK), and the Netherlands Organisation for Health Research and Development (ZonMw).
