**Service Statement Since Last TFR (2016-2020)**

In the last few years, my administrative roles have expanded both in the department and the university. Since my last TFR, I have served on IRB (2015-2019), on the CSBS Faculty Search Advisory Committee (2018-2019), and on the steering committee of the Latin American Studies (2009-2020), and I have also served as Developmental Area Coordinator (2016-2019).

In 2019, I became the director of the Psychology program at UAC. In this role, I have hired three faculty and spearheaded the development of faculty research labs and an internship program. Related to this role, I have also served on the UAC Executive Committee as well as on the search for the new UAC Dean of Faculty.

Also in 2019, I became the director of the Tanner Center for Human Rights Advocacy. To this role I brought a new vision for the center—one that would be more organically connected to the mission of our college. I developed and submitted a proposal for a new interdisciplinary certificate (currently under consideration at the Undergraduate Council) that involves multiple colleges at the university as well as multiple human rights advocacy agencies in Salt Lake City. Successful fundraising (\$450,000) as well as an internal reorganization of the Center's administration will allow us to support this new program along with existing and newly emerging Center priorities.
